## PLAYERS / PARENTS CONTRACT CODE OF CONDUCT

It is the intention of the Wakefield Parks and Recreation League to adhere to and promote the following statement of fact:

No one person or group of persons, this includes a player, Manager, Coach, League Official, Umpire, parent or parents, fan or fans, spectators and invited guests to one of our Leagues programs should never be embarrassed, intimidated or harassed at any time before, during or after one of our League events, this includes on the field or at the ball park facility.

Under no circumstances and in no way shape or form, will offensive language be tolerated at any game or program. It is that all parties of all ages will conduct themselves with regards to controlling their speech at all times. Should offensive language occur, an Umpire, Supervisor or Director may warn or remove, at his or her discretion, the party or parties involved.

Before, during and after you have attended one of our programs or games it is expected that all individuals will follow and adhere to the League policy concerning proper conduct. We will not tolerate, in any way, shape or form, conduct which in the opinion of the Umpire, Official or Director, is deemed inappropriate. No one person should ever be subject to verbal or physical abuse or acts, which are harmful, distasteful or could cause irreparable damage to any individual or group.

Our League will promote at all times good sportsmanship and a sense of fair play. All parties are expected to show each other the respect that each of them deserve. Absolutely under no circumstances will our League tolerate or allow any individual or group to be disrespectful. Directors, Supervisors and Umpires are to ensure that all Managers, Coaches and Players when on the field follow this code of conduct at all times.

This league will not tolerate the use of alcohol or drugs at any event this includes the parking lots. There will be no smoking on or near the field of play including the dugouts by any person.

This league will not tolerate a Manager or Coach embarrassing, humiliating, or intimidating any player, their own children included, at any Parks and Rec event, including practices.

This League recognizes that on the field the Chief Umpire is the only Official. This is often a trying job, which requires good judgment and much practice. The Umpire has the right to eject any individual from a game or the field for unpartisan like conduct or violations of this code of conduct.

The purpose of the Parks and Rec is to insure that all children who have a desire to enjoy our programs can do so in a safe and nurturing environment. Please remember that we are doing all of this for our children and their safety and well being come first!

As a player or parent of a child involved in the Wakefield Parks and Rec, I have read, understand and agree to adhere to the Code of Conduct set forth by this league. I understand that a violation of this could result in my being prohibited from attending games and or practices and that the director or Official in charge has the right to have me removed from any game.
